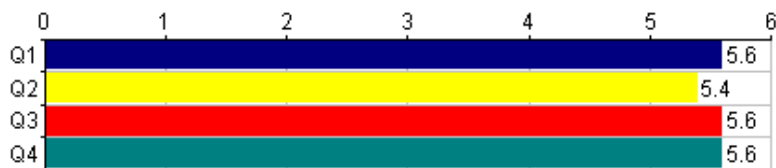

- The lab was not as beneficial as I would have hoped for. Maybe more in class practical assignments during lab to better understand the material, rather than a lecture.

The area that I think needs improvement is there are too many tests in this course. There has been almost a test every week in the semester which is extremely stressful and it is difficult to give attention to my other courses when I am studying for a statistics test almost every week. Also, there were times that I had to take a test when the exam material was not finished being taught but we had to take the exam anyway and I was extremely stressed trying to teach myself the rest of the material.

- For a statistics class Mr. Bubb made it as interesting and bareable as possible! Great teacher and very helpful!

- Robb and Beth were excellent instructors, but the class would have been more beneficial for me without an exam every week.

- The lab should be longer so the students can learn SPSS better. Fifty minutes is just not enough time.

Best teacher I've had so far in Auburn! I'm not a statistics person at all but he was so good at breaking down the material for all students who learn in different ways. He really wants all of his students to understand the material and succeed. I couldn't have asked for a more knowledgeable and kind hearted teacher.

Of all of the classes I was taking this semester, statistics probably intimidated me the most. However, as the semester is coming to a close, I am thrilled to say that this has been one of my favorite courses. I think the opportunity to re-take tests is brilliant. I also think the incentive of being able to finish the class early makes students want to strive to learn more. I also enjoyed getting to know my classmates throughout the semester as helping each other learn was imperative to success. I still don't understand how the lab/computer portion will really help us in the real world, but it was still interesting to learn. Overall, I am glad that I took this class!

- Computer tests often caused difficulties. Other than that excellent professor.

I don't like the new way of doing things in this class. Having multiple opportunities to take tests seems like a good idea in theory but it ended up causing more stress in the long run because you would be ready for tests that we hadn't even covered in class yet. I also did not like taking tests on the computer because if you miss something and realize it later there is no way for you to go back and correct it to get your points for it.

He realized that statistics is not enjoyable for most people but he tries his best to make it easy to learn. He was definitely one of the best teachers I've not; not only this semester, but since I've been attending Auburn.

Math has always been extremely difficult for me but Mr. Bubb explained the material in this class in a very easy to understand way. I enjoyed this class and I always knew I could go to him or Beth for help. Mr. Bubb was one of the best professors I've had because he explains material so well.

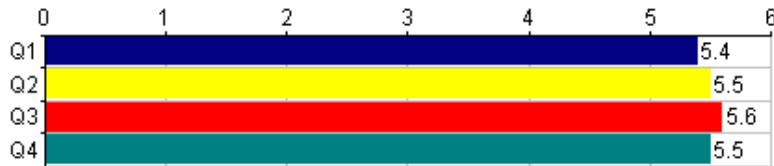

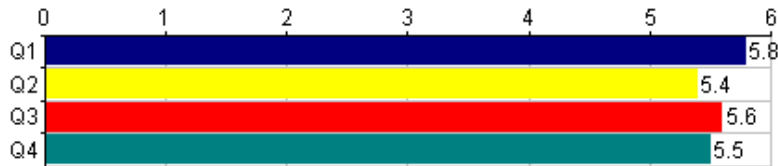

The new grading system with the ability to retake tests was a bonus- however it was hard to take a test almost every week of the semester. I don't think this system should be used in the future- it burns students out on the subject matter. Also- if you are ahead, class seems a little pointless. Other than that- I really liked the power-points and teaching style- it made a class with very difficult subject matter much easier to process!
- Great class and teacher!!
- Mr. Bubb was an awesome teacher. Gave us so many opportunities to succeed in his class. He was a hilarious teacher too. Love him!
- I was terrified of taking a STATS class, but he made sure all of the material was explained thoroughly. He always worked through problems and made sure everyone was on the same page. He made the material interesting and encouraged student participation and input. He was very approachable. He made an effort to learn everyone's names and say hello to his students. He really made Stats interesting and I would love to have him as a teacher again if I could.
- The only thing that I think should change for this class is how often we have tests. I have other classes that need just as much if not more attention than this class and it was hard to keep up especially when we were not finished with the course material. I know that others in the class were stressed out as well. I would not have been able to teach myself the course

material because I honestly just did not have extra time. When Mr. Bubb went through the entire section I did much better on the tests then when I had to go through and guess on things I had not learned yet.

Not having a test every week. It was very stressful and did not motivate me. I wish instead we could have taken quizzes or online practice exams to prepare us for the tests. This class was very difficult and the presentation didn't help with learning the material. I felt like most of the semester I had to teach myself the materials and I'm not very confident in my mathematic skills, and it is reflected in my grade."

Exam times are too short - Statistics is the hardest class I have ever taken and half the stress was making sure I worked quickly enough on the exams. The lecture days were 1 hr 15 min and the lab/exam days were only 50 minutes. The exams should have been given during the lecture days so we had an hour and 15 minutes instead of only 50.

- A great part of the class is all of the retakes we get on tests and the bonus points for attendance. Those were great incentives and should be used again in future classes.

This course SHOULD NOT BE REQUIRED FOR HDFS majors. Half of us will never use statistics in the work we do, so making this class required for HDFS should be changed.

- Robb is one of my favorite teachers at Auburn. I was skeptical about stats this year, but Robb did such an amazing job teaching and made it extremely easy for me to comprehend.
