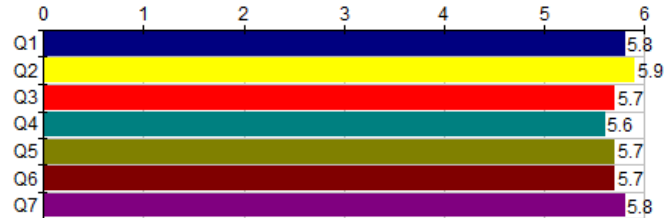

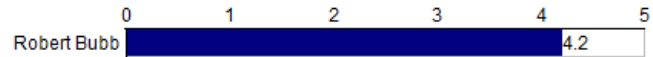

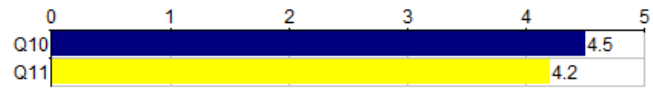
Q8 - Please provide additional actionable feedback related to instruction (strengths or areas of improvement).

Response Rate: 60.00% (6 of 10)
1 Very interactive class that required a lot of participation inside and outside of class. Communication between teacher and TA could have been better (TA would come to class and have different idea of where we were in the class, doesn't material as well as teacher, needed to look at notes frequently, although did great job of teaching what she knew), Wish there were more opportunities to improve grade, lots of difficult quizzes and assignments that had lots of difficult challenges. Was glad to learn how to work in excel and be active in a class (learning outside class through video lectures and practicing in class/reviewing).
2 Strengths: Ample opportunities for extra credit, practice exam, TA's were fun and easy to reach Weaknesses: Questions for modules were difficult so I would suggest making a 70% or higher equal full credit for lectures, this class required more work than any other class so I'd allow more time to learn and understand the lectures for the last 2 exams

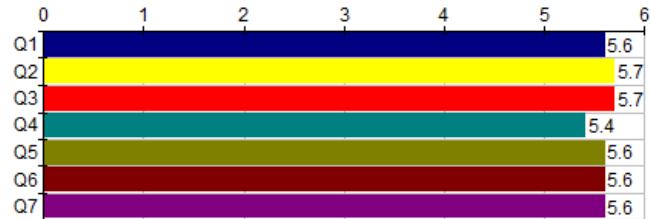

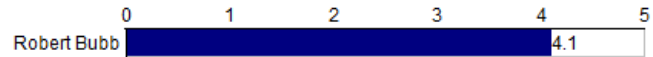

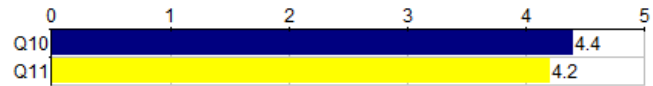
Q8 - Please provide additional actionable feedback related to instruction (strengths or areas of improvement).

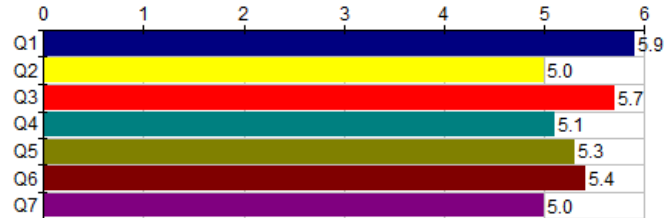

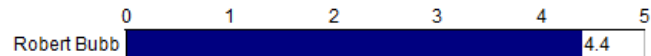

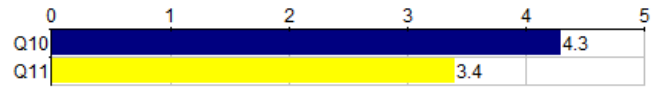

1	Rob improved this class from last semester. I appreciated that we spent most of the semester using SPSS instead of SAS and also thought that applying our learning by reading published articles was a helpful exercise. I felt encouraged when carrying out procedures on SPSS began to feel like second nature. There are still several ways I think the class could be improved. First, the amount of work required for this class was consistently overwhelming and gave me a lot of anxiety. Compared to other classes, stats consistently took up much more time and energy during my week. The articles we used for the reading worksheets were very difficult to understand and I learned very little from them. Additionally, I am still fuzzy about many of the core concepts about this class and think it would be helpful if Rob would slow down and make sure we're understanding what's going on. Lastly, we had to rent a textbook for the first couple weeks of class which was a lot of money for something we only used twice.
2	I loved it when Rob got back to me with feedback when I managed to turn in assignments early. Sometimes the feedback was inconsistent on paper rewrites.
3	An area of improvement would be consistency in grading. Rob told us there is always room for us to improve, and I do not disagree, but regarding grading I would get points off for not being concise and then the next week he would tell me to write more so there was no way to get the point either way. Overall, it was nice to be exposed to some new statistical packages!
