1	This class should never be taught as an online course.
2	The material covered in this course is dense and difficult for someone coming into this without any research background. I felt I could have been provided more direct answers and it would have helped me rather than searching for the answer myself, not finding it, then having to return for further instructions which still left me unsure of what to do with my findings or how to understand them. I understand the idea is not to just give answers out, we want students to work for it (because the learning "sticks" better) but with material this difficult, I'm still left with models and data I have to interpret and I don't know how. Direct answers would have helped.
3	Rob is honestly one of the best teachers/instructors I've ever had even though the class is quite challenging. He does not hesitate to show how much he cares for his students and their success, and he is always on top of grading, emails, answering questions, etc. The only suggestion I have is for the reading worksheets that require students to draw answers from an article of their finding. I would sometimes spend 2+ hours just searching for an article, so I think it would be helpful to give a list of applicable articles that students could choose from and then evaluate.
4	I think this class went much faster than last semester but Dr. Bubb still did a good job at relaying what information we needed to know. I wish that we would have been able to work through a few of the concepts more. I think that the small group activity we did with PCA/FA should be done with other topics such as transforms or logistic regression. I know that may not be easy to do but it really helped me develop a better understanding.
5	Dr. Bubb is a dedicated and thorough professor. I can always see his passion for stats through his teaching. He is very generous as a grader and with his time. He has always been willing to meet with me and provides revision opportunities for his assignments and grace periods for a lot of things overall. This class is very challenging, but Dr. Bubb is always slipping in opportunities to help us out. I do wish he was a little less ambitious during the transition to virtual instruction. I appreciated his dedication, but felt like I had to maintain the same pace and attentiveness, although circumstances were very different.
